Member reports:

- Glen attended the NSW Senior Long Track Championships at Quirinidi Showgrounds, run by Tamworth Motorcycle Club. Was impressed with the racing and spectators, large amount of female participation which was good to see. No major issues on track which is good.
- Mention was made that the East Coast Sidecar Roundup that was meant to be held on September 28 at Tamworth had been cancelled due to a lack of entries.

General business:

- Kevin got a call from the promoters of the National Historic Titles (being held at One Raceway, Goulburn on November 14-17) wondering where all the sidecar entries are. Kevin passed on the feedback from members about the price of entry and the unpopular decision to run all outfit classes together in the same events.

 Motorcycle Sports Club season. This class will include parallel 4 stroke twin up
 to 900cc including Yamaha XS 650 and XS 750, Horizontally opposed air cooled
 twins up to 750cc, air cooled 2 stroke twins up to 500cc excluding Yamaha TZ,
 any side valve V twin. Eligible outfits for this class will run in with P3's, other P4
 outfits will continue to run with P5 and P6 entries.
